Training course proposals for "Train the trainer" "Chain of Custody Collection Officers"



## Short background

- No qualification required to become a chain of custody collection officer
- Training may be carried out by Collection companies
- Independent training courses available but can differ in course content, size, and method of qualification
- Collection course, People do not travel abroad to do courses (unlike MRO's?)
- No standardisation exists
- EWDTS guidelines cover process.

## **EWDTS Proposals**

### **The What**

- Development of European guidelines/standards for the training of Chain of custody collection officers
- To include the development of relevant qualifications, practical and theory tests
- A web-based theory test after taking the practical course could be designed.
- EWDTS certified after passing test and attending course

- EWDTS could approve the organization that provide training.
- National Organization to give course and to supervise student during web based exam
- Key is the national organizations giving course and supervising exam
